This position will be responsible for actively participating in coordinating, analyzing, and acting upon information and feedback of customer needs, pricing, products, competition, and procedures.

- Develop, implement, and maintain corporate purchasing systems and procedures, enabling purchases from suppliers with the best delivery terms, quality, and total cost performance
- Manage and negotiate with suppliers, traveling to suppliers, as needed
- Perform supplier financial analysis and lead supplier selection
- Perform Make vs Buy Analysis
- Lead benchmarking and analysis for competitive cost structure
- Collaborate with Production, Sales, and Engineering to determine supply needs.
- Develop material cost forecasts and estimates based on engineering design and specifications
- Identify inefficiencies and cost gaps in already sourced commodities
- Support identification of material cost optimization and process improvement opportunities
- Expedite material from suppliers, ensuring accurate and timely delivery of product and necessary certifications.
- Supervise and lead 1 or 2 people, working closely with purchasing coordinators to effectively manage material demand and supply flow.
- Play a pivotal role in establishing our supply chain in Asia
- Administer supplier improvement process to include quantitative supplier performance measures for quality and delivery performance.
- ROHS, REACH and Conflict Mineral Compliance reporting is a plus
- Execute Continuous Improvement initiatives: focus on cost savings and gross margin improvement.
- Investigate and resolve any variances between inventory reports and physical inventory
- Other duties as assigned by management.
